Question: What TargetSolutions courses count toward continuing education credit for my certifications?

Answer: A list of approved courses is on the other side of this document.

Question: If I take a TargetSolutions course for CE credit toward my certification, do I need to report those hours to the Fire College? Or is it automatic?

Answer: TargetSolutions reports completions of the approved courses to the Fire College, as long as the user has an FCDICE student number in the FCDICE student number credential. You can check this by logging in and selecting "My Credentials" from the left side of your home page. If you see FCDICE student number listed in "My Credentials," TargetSolutions will report your hours to the Fire College.

Question: What do you need from me to report my information to Fire College?

Answer: All we need to be able to report to the Fire College is the FCDICE student number of the user.

Question: When will completions post on the Florida State Fire College website?

Answer: Reporting is done on or around the 15th of the following month and completions should post within a week after being reported. So, if a user takes a class on October 1st or October 30th, it should post on or around November 22nd. Users should not be concerned if they do not see completions right away.

Question: I'm the administrator and I notice that not only do you ask for the FCDICE student number, but also Fire-safety Inspector I, Instructor I, Instructor II, Instructor III. I don't want to enter that information for my users. Do I have to enter that information in order for TargetSolutions to report hours to the Fire College?

Answer: All we need to be able to report to the Fire College is the FCDICE student number, but you will notice that we have other associated credentials available to you in your site. Credentials like Instructor 1 or Firesafety Inspector 1 have been created for your convenience and the convenience of your users. They do not need to be filled out for your users in order to report their completions to the Fire College or for the Fire College to appropriately apply the training hours to their certification(s).

Question: What are the benefits to tracking not only FCDICE student numbers, but the associated credentials as well?

Answer: There are benefits to tracking these credentials, not only for your own reporting and tracking purposes, but also for the user. All of these credentials link to the certification trackers on the My Credentials page. You can run reports to track completion status.

Question: I'm the Administrator and I instruct custom training approved for recertification hours by the Fire College. If I create a Custom Activity to track this training, will TargetSolutions report the completions to the Fire College?

Answer: No, TargetSolutions can only report TargetSolutions courses to the Fire College. However, feel free to create the activity and attach it to the applicable credential. This will make the activity show up in the FCDICE-associated certification trackers and completions will count toward the CE hours showing as available. You will still need to report the completions of that custom training to the Fire College.
